A World Heritage site at a glance











Since 2002 the Historic Centres of Stralsund and Wismar are listed as UNESCO World Heritage Site. The medieval town structure with brick churches, merchants' houses and the harbour has been preserved almost unchanged to this day. Once flourished in the shelter of offshore islands Stralsund and Wismar fell into the hands of the Swedish king after the Thirty Year's War and became fortresses of European rank. Up to today, in both towns you can still sense the political influence of the Hanseatic trading power.
